Communication from H. R. H.
Prince Regent, to H. R. H. Prince of
Wales, by the Earl of Liverpool
10th July [1812]

When H. R. H. Prince Regent made
the arrangement respecting H. R. H. Prince
Charlotte's residing at Windsor, he signified
that it was His Royal Highness's intention
that the Prince Charlotte should visit
H. R. H. Prince of Wales once a fortnight.

The Prince Regent having understood that
the Prince of Wales had been at Windsor
to visit the Prince Charlotte, Lord
Liverpool waited upon the Prince of
Wales to communicate to His Royal
Highness, the Prince Regent's wish
that the Prince of Wales should not

go there in future unless by His
Royal Highness's previous consent.

Her Royal Highness Princess of
Wales replied to Lord Liverpool, that
as it was customary for the Princess
Charlotte to come once a week to her
she expected to have the same gratification
that in that case, Her Royal Highness's
going to Windsor would be unnecessary.
