liberty of adding that I am extremely
concerned & surprised at your Royal
Mighty not condescending to take
the slightest notice of me but
right at Lady Hampden, for I can
with truth assure you Sir, I have
served your Royal Majesty with
fidelity & faith fully in the most
difficult situation in which I have
being ever was placed - My
resignation is always ready to be
laid at your feet & delivered over your
