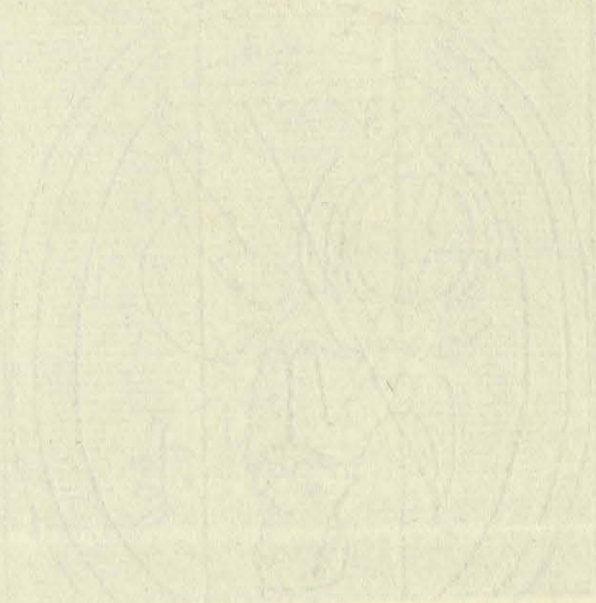

Her Majesty graciously proposed to lend Lady Mchester for the present moment to assist in the new Establishment.

To find that this has met with H. H.'s Approbation is doubtless highly flattering

flattering to Lady Chester, who, in obedience
to Her Majesty's Command will to the
utmost of her Power act conformably to the
Orders with which She may be honored by

suggest to Her Majesty a Wish to commence
