Sir,

I have for some time had Reason to expect the arrival of a packet from you, under cover to Lord Keith, in consequence of a Letter that was addressed to you from London in the month of August last - I am now desired to inform you, that the disappointment has been severely felt in a quarter, where any intimation or disrespect ought not to have taken place, and I am also commanded to require an immediate compliance with the directions contained in the Letter, alluded to, as a further delay must inevitably produce the unpleasant consequence of a full and explicit disclosure of every thing that has passed

to Cap^t Vernon of the Challenger Brig, who
sailed from hence about the end of August.
