My Lord

A short time ago I received
a letter from your Lordship, & should
have answered it before this, had I been
stationary but for one day, but our Regt
has been moving about in so many
different directions that I could not find
sufficient time to send you the parcel
I intend sending— Even now, it is

me that he would send this letter off
that I take the liberty of sending
you these few lines merely to tell you,
that the parcel shall be sent next
week for certain according to your Regt

own directions - I shall then also
take the liberty of speaking more
fully to your & ship on the subject
in question -
