My Lord - Although I had promised to write several weeks ago, we have had so much to do, with regard to military matters, that I could not find either time or a safe opportunity of getting a parcel conveyed, being not far from Bordeaux now, I shall send it to Lord Dalhousie who I hope will take care of it, and get it conveyed to England - I have told your Lordship once before, but like to repeat it, "that nothing of what I have received from la personne en question, in writing, is still in existence

Those articles, which I have got with
me out here, I shall deliver up
after my arrival in England -
I have a favor to ask of you which
is, to forward the enclosed parcel
to its destination, without having
it opened by any body but the person
it is to go to; I trust my Lord
the favor I ask will be granted
& have the honor to be
