Convent Letter

My dearest Father

Having for the last week  
been occupied upon some important  
matters I could not introduce sooner  
that of left consequence - allow me

to ask you what day you propose that  
I should come with with to Town  
for the morning sooner? The Queen

I find it to be at the Queen's House  
on Tuesday. If it could not be in the  
evening with your plans for me should  
you allow me to come up on Monday.

It is not so much for myself, as for  
the Ladies but to visit me to the  
morning sooner, with it necessary that  
I should have a day or two to work

 Ladies wrote & kept at Carlton House  
 & it would be quite the same to her  
 would you permit that I might

 myself to do that, being I am still  
 me with however I may lament
