

The French before 1749 were in possession
 In the Coromandel Coast - only
 Pondicherry - Chief Settlement
 Karikal a Comptoir; & a Factory
 at Nagulipatnam & another at Ganassan

In the Malabar Coast
 a small Fort at Aniki & a Factory
 at Surat & another at Callicut. -

In Bengal -
 Chandernagur - Chief Settlement - with
 a small Factory or Residence at each
 of the 5 following places - viz -
 Balasore - Cosimbazar - Patna, Sugden
 & Dacca - merely to purchase goods.

In 1749 Charanbehari ceded to the French the
 Lands of Villenour & Bahour adjoining
 to Pondicherry with 80 Villages belonging.

Treaty signed the end of Dec: 1754 by the
English, & French Governments on the 1st
& sent home for final determination.

The two Companies to renounce for ever all honours,
Governments & Dignity

Majumpatnam & Divi to be Neutral. Each
Nation, as shall be determined from
some, to have one with equal distance
round them for Comptoirs, & an equal
number of Soldiers to guard them -

Surampour river to be alike free to both
Nations, each a Factory on its Banks
& the districts to be equal to - Commerce
to be alike free to both Nations, and
the Custom Houses to remain on the
same footing as before the war, & no
alterations made in the Duties paid on the
importation, & exportation of Goods - The Trade
or Manufacture of the Coast. —
