It is humbly submitted to
Your Majesty, That if the
Court of France will agree to
the

Preliminary Articles as now
drawn up; And that if Spain
will besides Minorca restore
the Islands of the Bahamas, and
allow a well regulated Establish-
ment on some Part of the Coast
of Honduras, The Proposal of
exchanging Gibraltar for Gua-
delupe may be accepted.

And it is further submitted
to your Majesty that in Conside-
ration of West Florida being
kept by Spain, The Island of
Trinidad should be ceded to
your Majesty in Addition to
the above Offer.
