Sir

I take the opportunity
of I temwards returning to England to
trouble your Majesty with a few lines to
entreat that you will have the goodness
to continue your protection to this poor
Man who has behaved very well during
his stay here and would have remained
with me if he had not met with a
bad fall at Frankfurt which makes
him afraid of spending the Winter here
as it is the custom for the Servants to
stay all day in the Passages. I should
not have the liberty to enter into such
particulars with your Majesty but
feared that if I did not explain

the reason of his going it might
enquire him.

In the course of next Month we
expect the Archduke who is to spend a
Week in the Dutchy that he may
review between thirty and forty
thousand men who are to form three
Camps.

The Prince begs that I will present
his humble duty to Your Majesty and
I have the honour to be with the
greatest respect
