that special Protection of which we have
already seen so many evident marks. —

After having had very fine Weather all
November in which I walked most days

on the Road we have now constant Trains
which except every other day in the Coach
prevent my going out. I notice the Roads are
so spoilt by the constant Carriage of Austrian
Artillery {which is now for the fourth time
going through the Dutchy} that it is nothing
but looking on it as a duty that could
persuade me to go out as much as I do.

If Your Majesty has the same Trains in
England I am afraid that both Your
Hunting and your Farming must suffer
from it.
