Louisbourg March 22^d
1799

Sir

No material alteration
has taken place here since I had
the honour of writing to Your
Majesty: but at about fifty miles
distance I imagine there has: though
we can obtain no information on
the subject. The French who on
the 17th had almost left the Dutchy
on the 19th began to return, as yet
we are all ignorant of the cause.

I have this Morning

taken the Sacrament, which is a
great comfort in these times, as it
quiets the mind; and makes it look
up for Protection, from whence alone
we can hope to receive support in
every situation

Our weather continues uncertain
and a great many people are
ill, being suddenly taken with
very violent feverish Colics, which
appear to me like the old Influenza

The Duke begs that I will
present his humble duty to your
Majesty -
