Delicacy has alone long prevented me addressing you a few lines, for to entreat you to take an active part, in favour of my poor Daughter the Princess Catherine of Montfort, who being in the same situation of the Empress Mary Louisa, and that of the Princess Augusta of Bavaria might with reason have hoped to have been treated as favourably. I have suffered very much on Catherine's account, which will make you the more easily believe the joy I felt at hearing from her that

you had been so good as to order Sr Charles
Stewart to write himself to the Imperial,
Imperial, and Wurttemberg Ministers to
obtain my Daughters a settlement due
to her rank and the promises which
had at different times been made to her.

I am my dearest Brother most grateful
to you on this subject, and my Son the
King of Wurttemberg has also desired
me to express his thanks.
