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My dearest Brother

Daily accounts of Victo'rys &c if it should please God that we should beat the French they will be over and very soon, for the Russians will force the King of Prussia to declare himself, when they pass the line of Ternavation, which must be soon as they are already in Germany, such an obstinate King that will not follow the advise of his Ministers General &c &c, the Duke of Franckfort has been generally blamed, from the Improperity of a King & Queen being in town, the whole journey was thought unseasonable, one piece of news I will mention, that the Duke does not believe it, that all the Princes that were in the adjacent parts, sent to beg that he would protect them, he said that at present he could do nothing, tell the decisive answer to his demands,

where refused, by restoring Magnance & Charente, it
