Dear Brother,

I received with the last Post Your letter of the 17<sup>th</sup> and the Power of Attorney which I now return You, after having done as You had directed me. I have seen Mad<sup>e</sup> de Pleſſe she is vastly weakened since I saw her last, she was here for some days, but would not stay longer, as her health did not permit it. The Ladies that are here with me, believe as well as possible to me, I believe that Mad<sup>e</sup> Omteda would remain with me, if it was offered her, though she has not mentioned it to me, but has talked of it to Mad<sup>e</sup> de Pleſſe, there has been here some Italian Singers, that have performed here several times.
