under Our Royal Sign Manual, and on
the Sixth Day of April 1753. deposited
in Your Hands, pursuant to an Act of
Parliament passed in the Twenty Fourth
Year of Our Reign, to provide for the
Administration of the Government, in
case the Crown should descend to any
of the Children of Our Son Frederick
late Prince of Wales, being under the
Age of Eighteen Years, and for the Care.

receive the said Instrument, and deliver
the same to Us. Given at Our Court at
St. James's the Twenty Second Day of
March 1757.
