I order him to send you a Copy of the minutes
I am for Mr Guidott has undertaken to make the Draft to be ready for your perusal & to be approved of by such Counsel as both sides shall think proper to appoint
By the time ye you & the rest of Gentlemen of a profession shall be coming back to town I am very well satisfied that the terms will appear in good light & I dare say will be approved on as a good bargain I am very glad to hear ye you have found so much benefit by Bristol & hope ye they will find you in perfect health
