

Extract of a Letter from Capt.
 Davers Command^r of His Ma^{ty}'s
 Ship the Dolphin to M^r Burdett
 At Barbadoes 27th June 1728.

When I was at Martinico I receiv'd a Letter
 from the General giving me an Account of a
 Spanish Guard de Costa a Sloop of Ten Guns &
 Eighty Men, which had fired and spoke to sev.
 French Vessels between Dominico & Martinico
 but did not detain them but declared they were
 fitted out from Porto Rico against the English
 upon Account of the Money that was kept at
 Antegoa which was taken from a Spanish
 Work at Barbuda. I weigh'd immediately upon
 receiving this Advice and ran down to Dominico
 but I had not the good Fortune either to see
 her or hear any thing of her.
