

Extract of a Letter from Edward
 S. Lo. Esq. at Jamaica Dated at
 Port Royal the 14th Septem. 1728.
 to M^r. Burchott.

I take leave to acquaint You for the Informa-
 tion of my Lords of the Admiralty, that the
 Chatham which I had some time ago sent to St
 Domingo to demand Restitution for the Ship
 Dolphin and her Cargo, taken the 9th of June last
 by a Spanish Privateer is returned from thence,
 and her Men all healthy; When Captain Fowkes
 arrived there, the Governor had not received
 the Preliminary Articles, but I sent them to him
 for his Perusal, which I hope will put a Stop
 to any further Proceedings of this kind.
