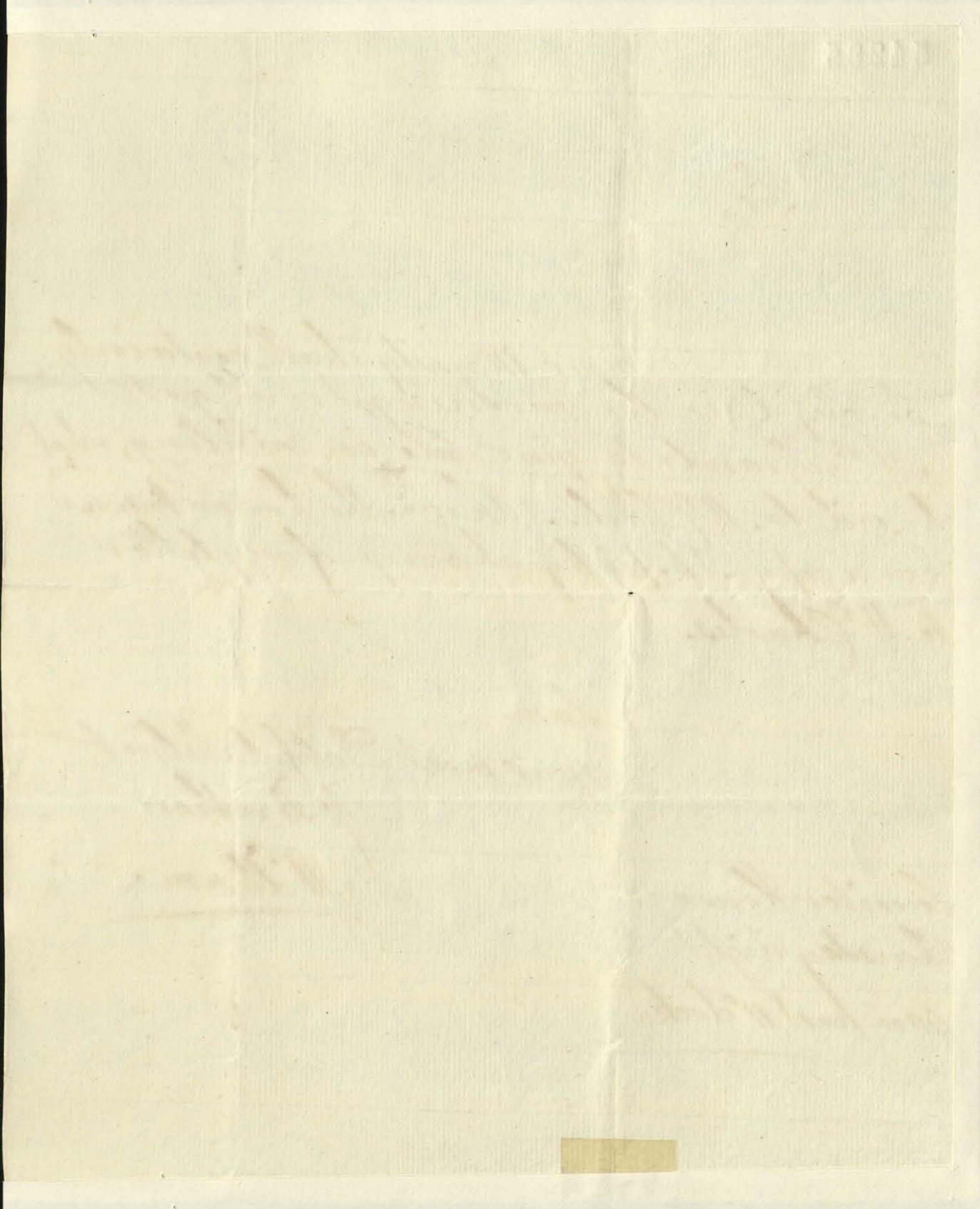
Sir,
