Sir,

I did not mean to trouble Your Majesty with a letter to day; but I thought you might be curious to hear a confirmation of the news I had the honor to communicate to you last post. The Gentleman I met at Genoa is not yet returned here; he went only to Bologna where he was to meet a Countess Stolberg, and he is to be married there; and will return in a few days with her; she is a Chanciers of Mons, her Sister is married to the D. of Bernick. I leave this place on Tuesday next; I shall ~~only~~ stay one day at Florence to see the Grand Duke, and then shall immediately embark at

at Leghorn for Nice. As the Physicians with
me not so well fast, it may be the 2^d or
29^d of May before I shall be in England, when
I hope I shall have the honor to find both
you, and the Queen, well.
