The King of Sardinia desired me to Express to your Majesty the Great Regard, and Respect he has for you; he entered very largely into the Old Connections with England, and wished me to convey to you his Warm Attachment to you Personally.

If I might presume to offer my advice, with a small house at Weymouth I should wish your Majesty to send her there for the three Winter Months. I suppose we need to Nice or Naples, she could not find a better Climate

when I first went to Weymouth I was in a
very bad way; and I found my recovery increasing
every day, and in less than a month was able to
walk, which I am convinced is the surest of all
cures for complaints of the breast where the Lungs
are but slightly touched. I hope Sir you will forgive
the liberty I have taken, but the Attachment
I have to Your Majesty, may be my Excuse.
