I Received the enclosed from my Sister this Morning; in Her letter to me She expresses how happy Your letter, has made the Duke, and Her. She adds, how much She is Satisfied with the conduct of Her Daughter upon this Event. She says She has Write a long letter to the King, and that She is sending me a private letter, by an Irish Gentleman. She strongly recommends, that Her Daughters (Lenths) should be chiefly White, as that becomes Her most. In short She is quite delighted, as I heartly hope you will be when you see your beautiful Bride. I leave this place on Tuesday, and shall be in Town on Thursday morning the 25th. Adieu on ~~my~~ my here.
