Sir,

I went to Carlisle House at two o'clock
to give Your Majesty's letter, and return the
Papers to the Princess of Wales. I found Her much
agitated, and out of spirits; I shall have the
honour to come on Wednesday to the Queen's

Prince had kept in Town, I went up to the
Prince to desire to see him; but I was inform'd
he had just set out for Windsor.
