Presents shall be your Sufficient Warrant and Discharge in this  
behalf Given at Leicester House the Seventeenth day of April  
1751. In the Twenty fourth Year of the Reign of our Royal  
Father the King

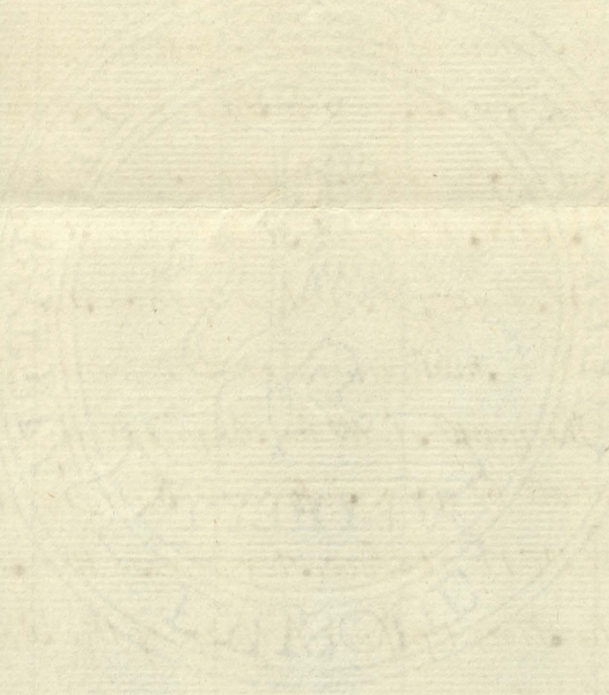
