R. in Cypher, each pair weighing about 50 Ounces as before The King Allowed His Barge Master 60^l & Ann besides his Salary, for keeping the Barges; the late Prince 40 The late Princes Watermen had at First Brass Badges Silver gilt in Common; two or three Years afterwards they were set aside, & each Waterman had One Silver Badge of Feathers weighing 20 Ounces little more or less. each

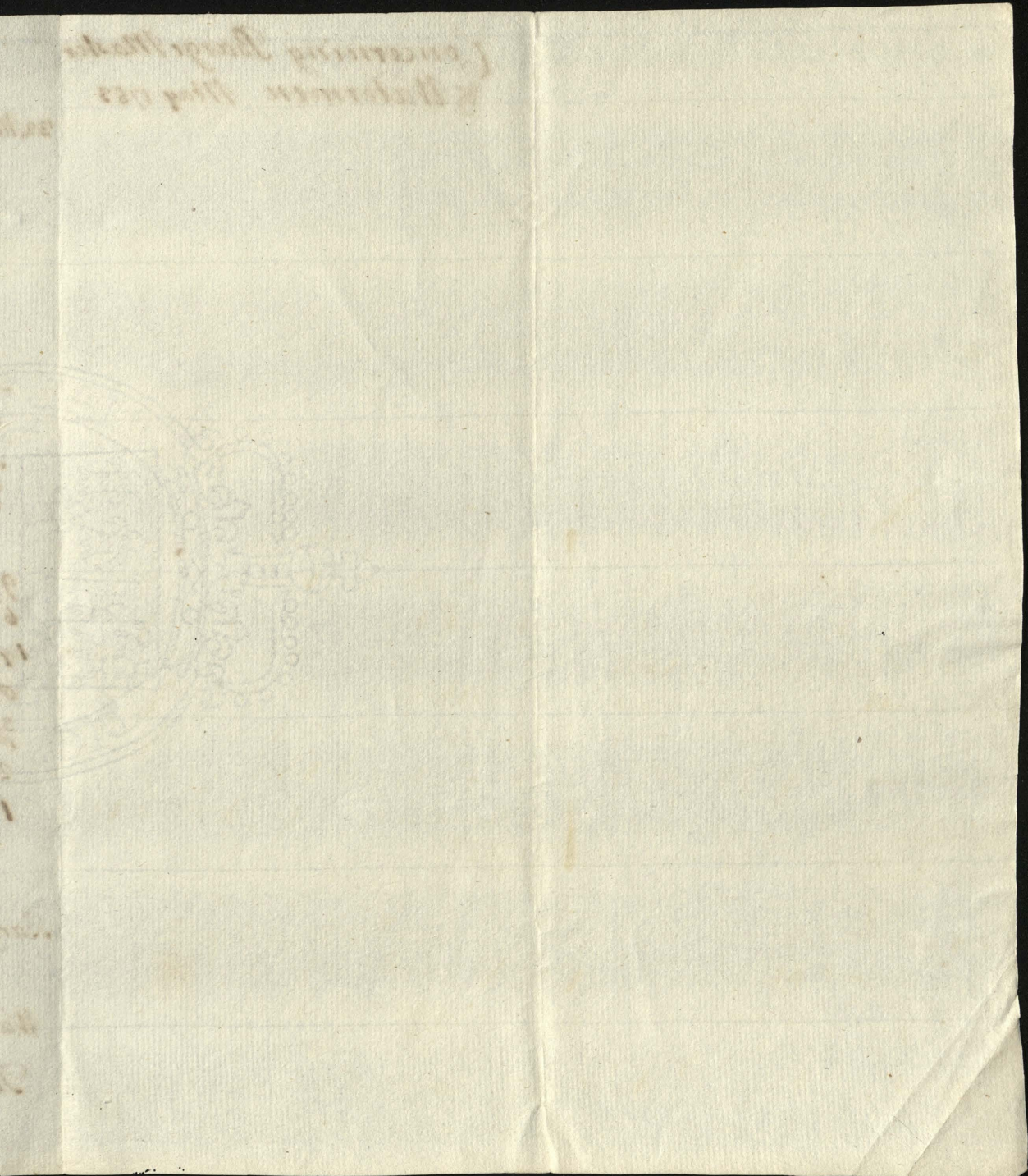
