 When the King came to Crown the Watermen to the Queen
 instead of the Feathers had for their Badges C.R. in
 Cypher, each pair weighing about 50 Ounces as before
 The King Allowed His Barge Master 60 £ and besides
 his Salary for Keeping the Barges, the late Prince 40
 The late Prince's Watermen had at first Brass Badges Silver
 Gilt in Common; two or three Years afterwards they were
 set aside, & each Waterman had One Silver Badge of
 Feathers weighing 20 Ounces little more or less. each


