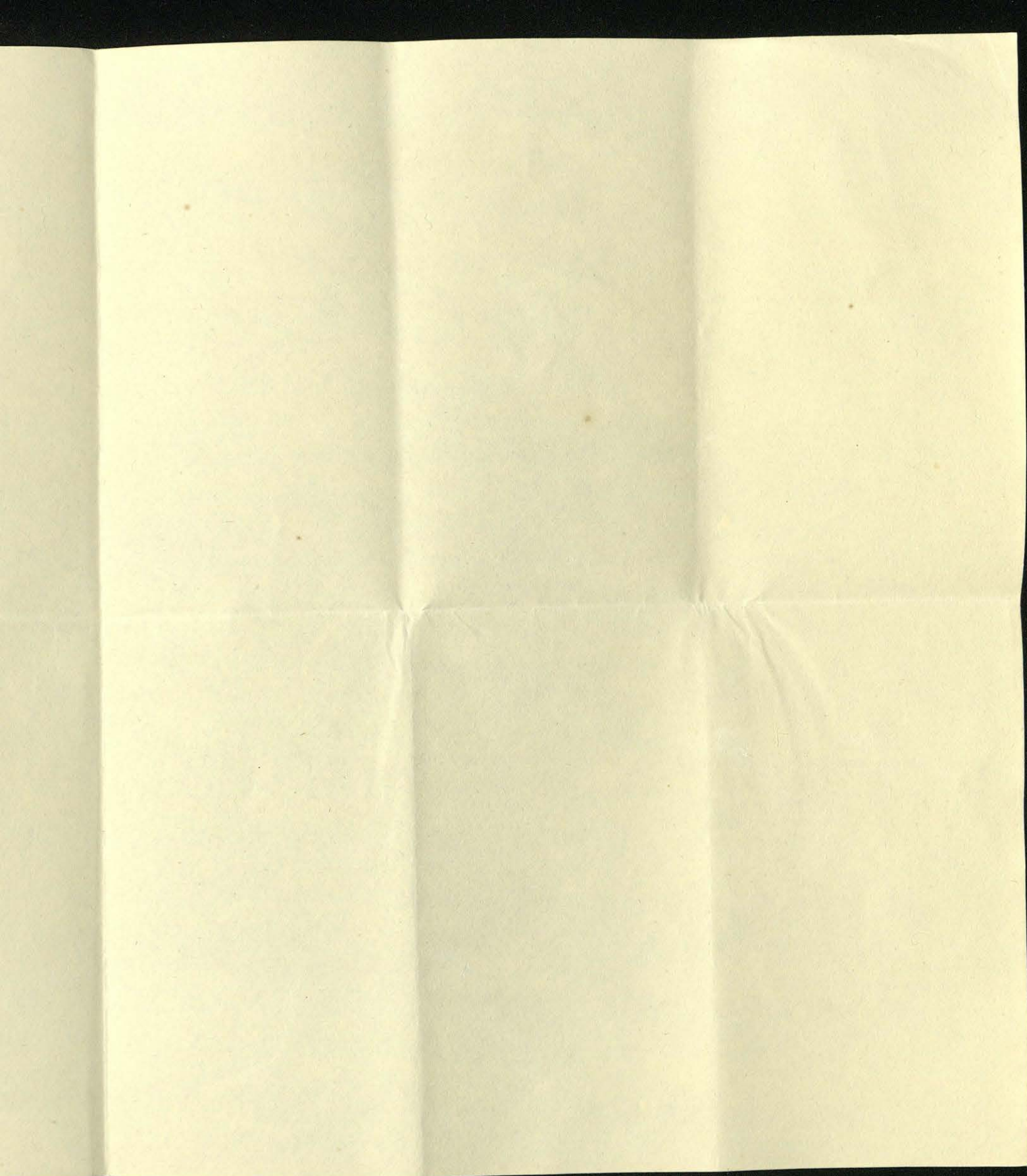

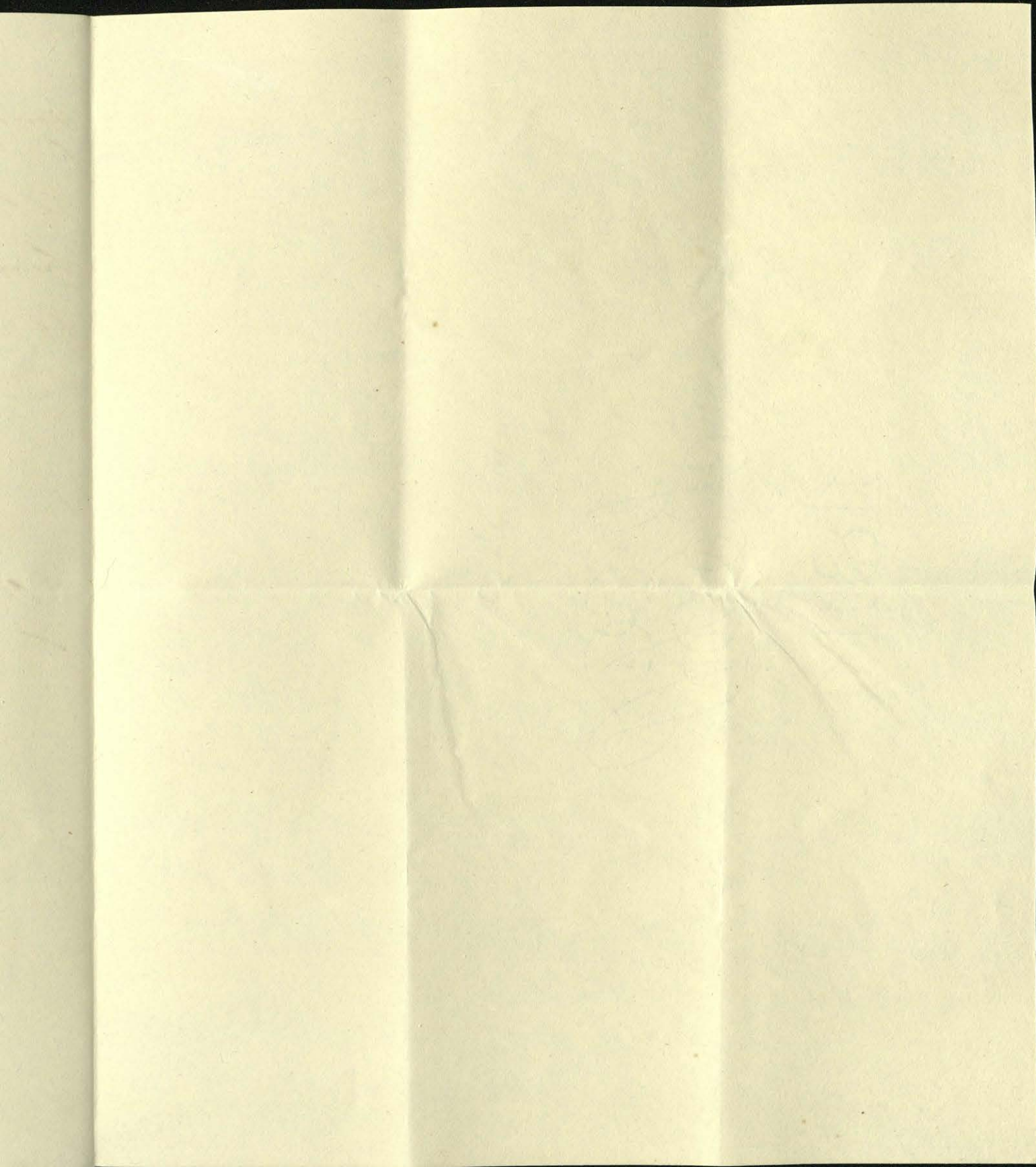

some years passed to herself



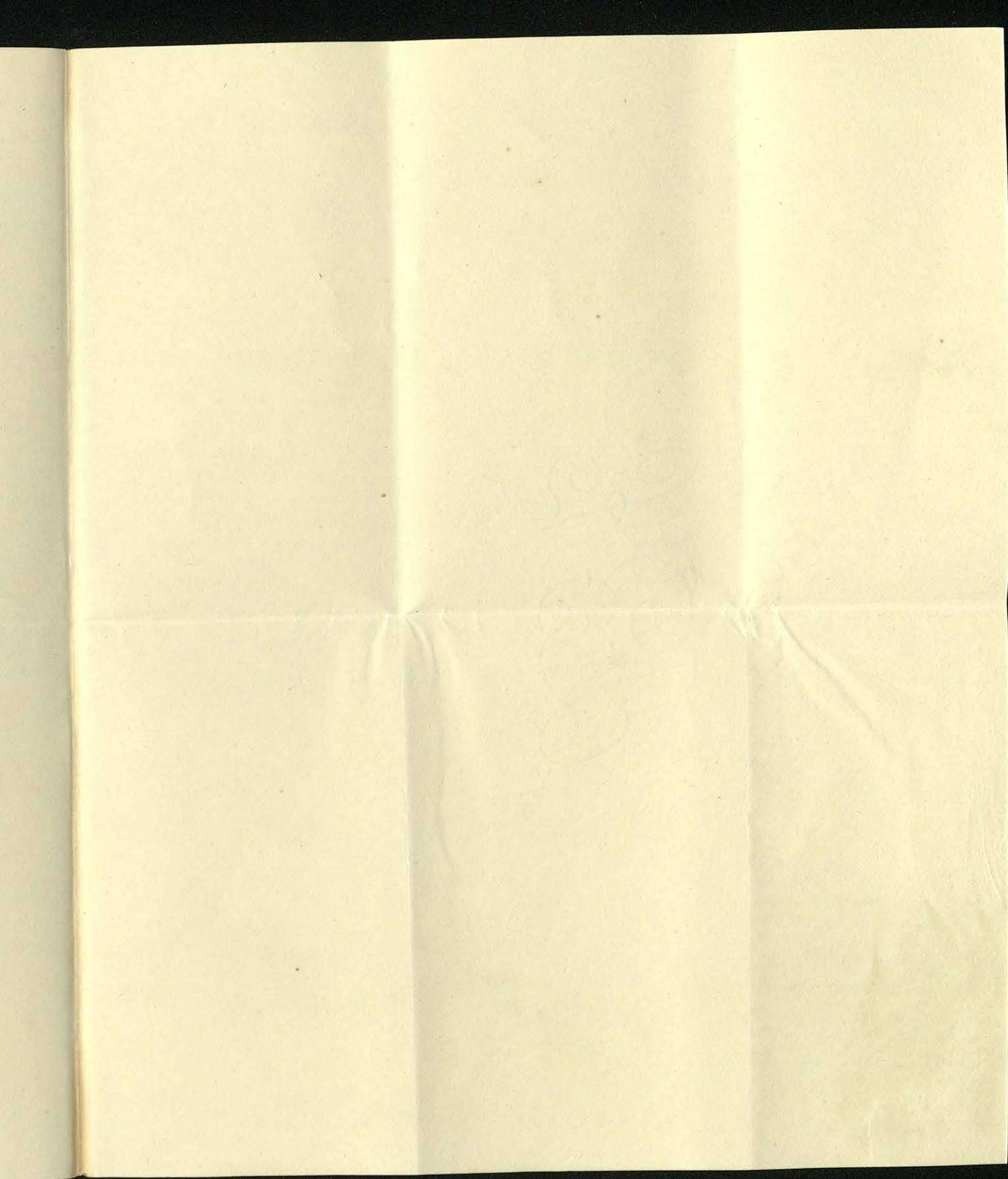
